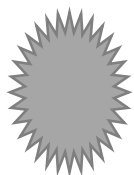

Aucuba

Aucuba japonica 'Variegata'

Shrub - Evergreen



- **Soil:** Well-drained moist soil with organic matter
- **Bloom Time:** Grown for foliage rather than flowers; produces small purple flowers in spring and bright red fruit in fall
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Poisonous leaves and fruits



Camellia

Camellia sasanqua 'Yuletide'

Shrub - Evergreen



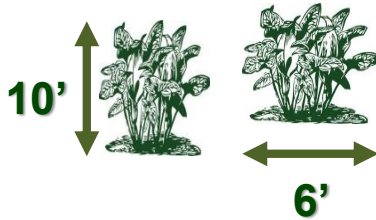
- **Soil:** Well-drained, acidic, high in organic matter
- **Bloom Color:** Crimson red centered with bright yellow stamens
- **Bloom time:** Fall
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Foliage Color: Dark Green
- Erect, compact
- Showy flowers



Japanese Falsecypress

Chamaecyparis pisifera 'King's Gold'

Perennial - Shrub - Evergreen



- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom:** Non-flowering
- **Fall Color:** Yellow
- **Foliage:** Evergreen
- **Seed:** Male and female cones
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Bright Gold Threadleaf foliage that does not burn in full sun
- Spreading mound



Isu Tree

Distylium myricoides

Shrub - Evergreen



- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom Color:** Red
- **Bloom Time:** Spring
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Related to Witch Hazels
 - Lateral branching habit
 - creates a layered effect
 - Dark glossy blue-green leaves



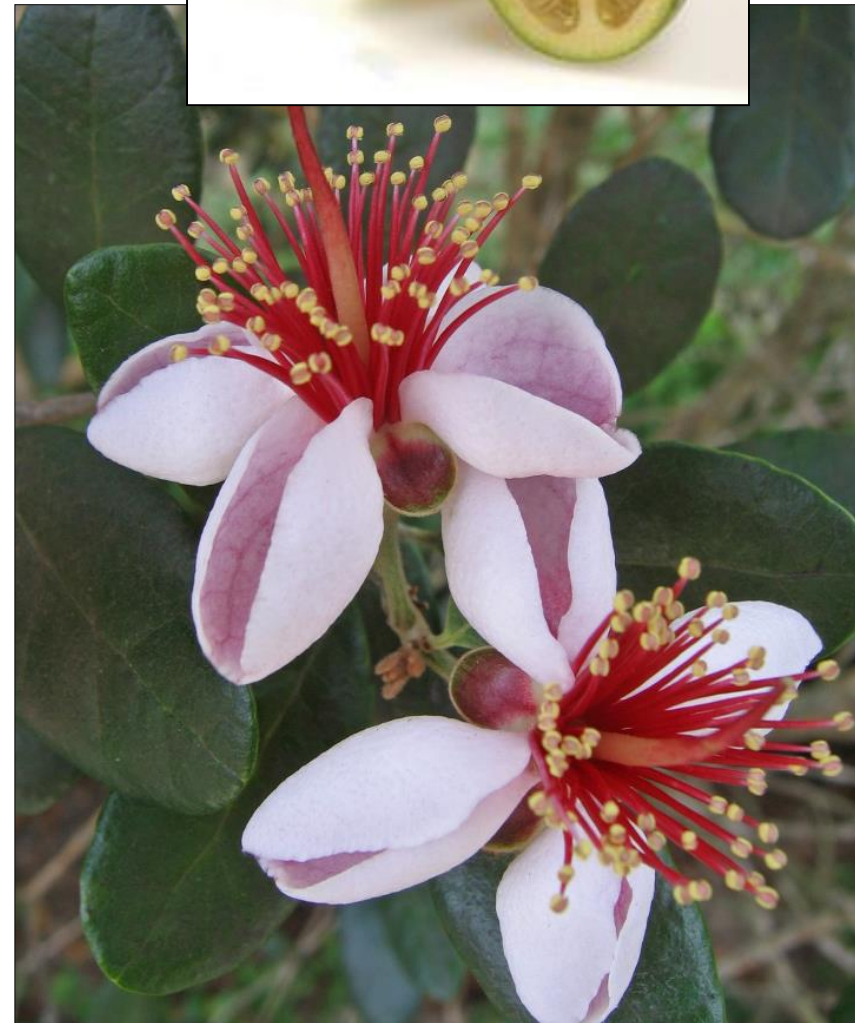
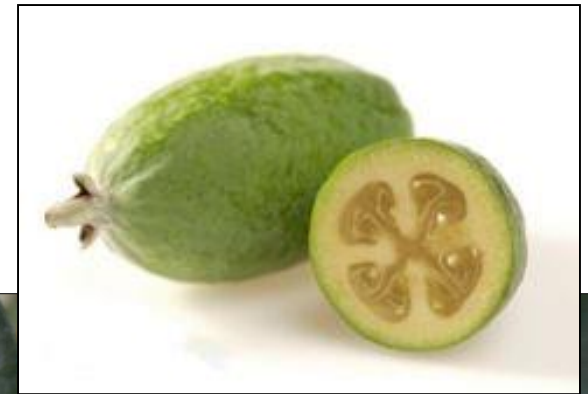
Pineapple Guava

Feijoa sellowiana

Shrub - Evergreen



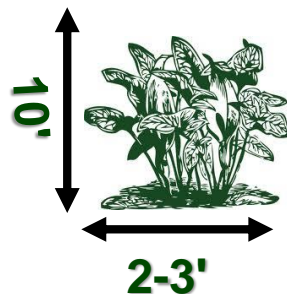
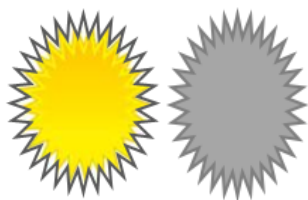
- **Soil:** Well drained
- **Bloom Time:** Early Summer
- **Bloom Color:** Pink and Red
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Tough evergreen, can be grown as a large shrub or small multi-stemmed tree
- Very drought tolerant
- Edible fruits (Feijoa) ripen late summer



Sky Pencil Japanese Holly

Ilex crenata 'Sky Pencil'

Shrub - Evergreen



- **Soil:** Light, moist but well-drained acidic soil
- **Bloom Color:** Small greenish-white dull flowers
- **Bloom Time:** May to June
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- A berry-like dark purple drupe ripens from September to October
- Lustrous dark evergreen leaves
- May struggle with heat and humidity



Yellow Anise Shrub

Illicium parviflorum

Perennial – Evergreen

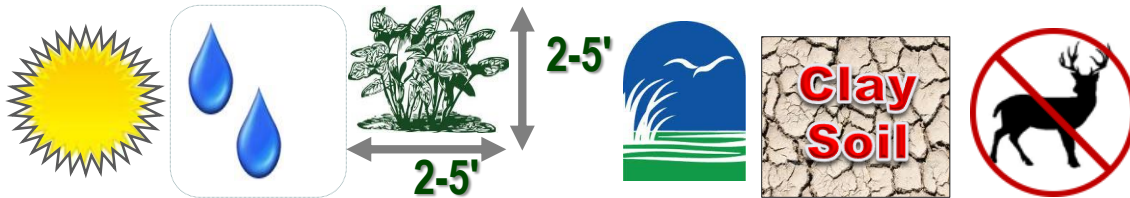


- **Soil:** Ranges moist to wet
- **Bloom Color:** Yellow-green flowers (not fragrant)
- **Bloom Time:** May to June
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Showy fruit-star shaped seed capsule
 - Fragrant, licorice scented leaves
 - Tolerates full sun if soil is kept uniformly moist
 - Easy to naturalize – branches root where they touch the ground
 - Use for hedges, screens, in rain gardens and as a patio tree. Low maintenance



Pocomoke Crape Myrtle

Lagerstroemia 'Pocomoke'
Shrub - Deciduous



- **Soil:** Loamy clay soils with good drainage
- **Bloom Color:** Showy rose pink
- **Bloom Time:** July to September
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Slow-growing miniature
 - Drought Tolerant!
 - Dark green foliage turns bronze red in fall



Jazz Hands® Loropetalum

Loropetalum chinensis 'Jazz Hands'® Dwarf
Shrub - Evergreen



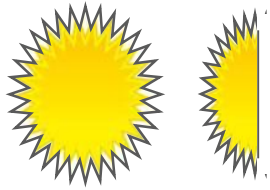
- **Soil:** Moist, well drained, acidic
- **Bloom Color:** White
- **Bloom Time:** Spring – sporadic re-bloom thru summer
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Very heat tolerant with few problems
 - Well adapted to Southern climate
 - Dwarf variety - very versatile. Use in containers, borders, foundation, specimen accent, or masses
 - Low maintenance



Banana Shrub

Michelia figo

Shrub - Evergreen



- **Soil:** Moist, slightly acidic
- **Bloom Color:** Creamy pale yellow
- **Bloom Time:** April - June
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Fragrant , showy flowers
 - Low maintenance, Foundation shrub or hedge
 - Late frost may damage blooms
 - Protect roots by mulching



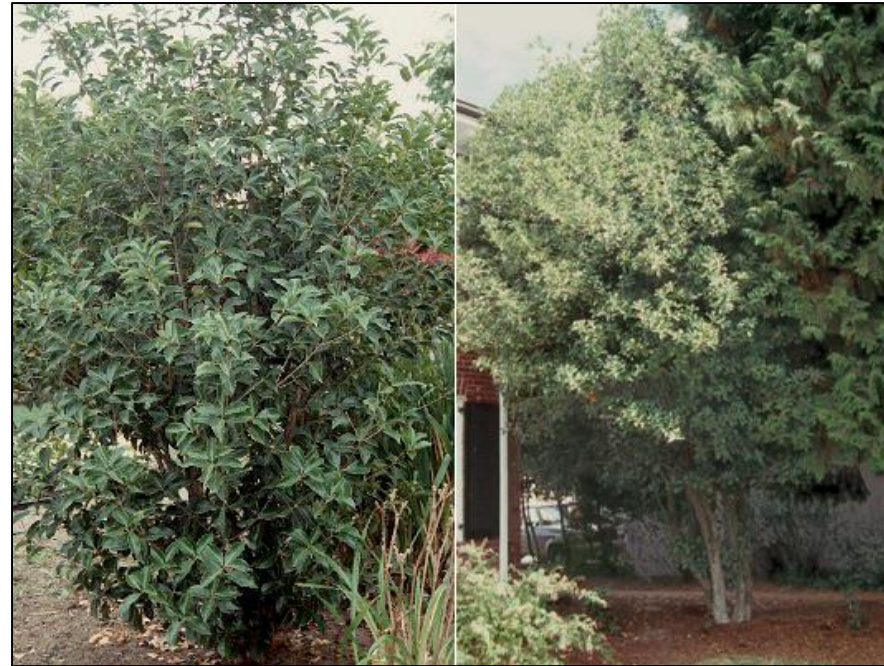
Fortune's Tea Olive

Osmanthus x fortunei

Shrub - Evergreen



- **Soil:** Fertile, acidic, well drained
- **Bloom Color:** Small white
- **Bloom Time:** Fall
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Wonderful fall fragrance - ideal for planting near windows and outdoor living areas
- Great barrier or hedge
- Growth rate - slow to moderate, 4 to 12 inches per year



Holly Osmanthus

Osmanthus heterophyllus 'Goshiki'

Shrub - Evergreen



- **Soil:** Well drained
- **Bloom Time:** Fall
- **Bloom Color:** Small, fragrant white flowers
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Dramatic variegated foliage lights up shady places
- Can be severely pruned



Compact Pomegranate

Punica granatum 'Compactum'

Shrub - Deciduous



- **Soil:** Organically rich, well drained
- **Bloom Color:** Orange-red
- **Bloom Time:** July – August
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Dense, compact growth habit
 - Crepe like flowers followed by edible fruit, used in jams/jellies
 - Grenadine syrup made from fruit
 - Foliage turns yellow green in fall



Satsuki Azalea

Rhododendron 'Matsu-no-arti'

Perennial – Evergreen - Shrub



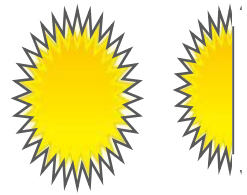
- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom Color:** Salmon
- **Bloom Time:** June
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Compact habit
- No wet feet
- Late bloomer for azaleas – spring into summer
- Good for massing, shrub borders, shade or woodland gardens.



Japanese Spirea

Spirea x bumalda 'Gold Mound'

Shrub - Deciduous



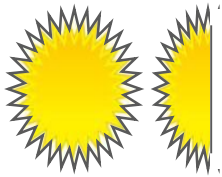
- **Soil:** Average, well drained
- **Bloom Color:** Rosy pink to carmine
- **Bloom Time:** Late spring
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Compact, dwarf plant
- Great color addition to shrubs, borders or in a pot on the patio
- Vibrant golden spring foliage followed by yellow-green in summer
- Turns to yellow and orange in Fall
- Does not tolerate wet soil



Cleyera

Ternstroemia gymnanthera

Shrub - Evergreen



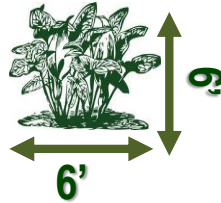
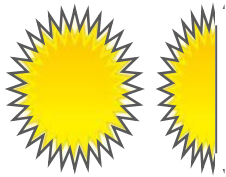
- **Soil:** Well drained, moist
- **Bloom Color:** Yellowish white on previous season's growth
- **Bloom Time:** Spring
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Winter Color: Reddish bronze (when grown in sun)
- Foliage: Lustrous dark green
- Seed: Oval green/speckled red berry
- Can be severely pruned, take care not to prune too late



Prague Viburnum

Viburnum x pragensense

Shrub - Evergreen



- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom:** Pink Buds White Bloom
- **Bloom Time:** Late Winter to Early Spring
- **Seed:** Blue/Black Fruit
- **Fall Color:** Dark Green
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Upright-rounded compact habit
 - Pink flower buds form in the winter
 - Green foliage with red stems

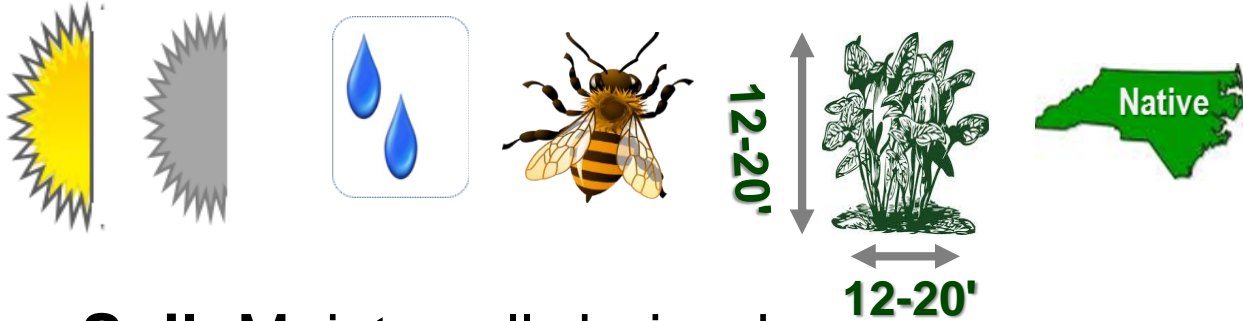


Trees

White Fringe Tree

Chionanthus virginicus

Tree- Deciduous



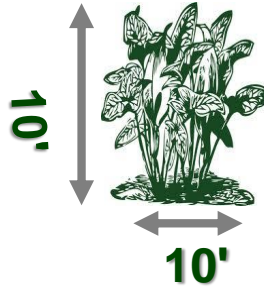
- **Soil:** Moist, well-drained
- **Bloom Color:** Creamy white, fragrant
- **Bloom Time:** April
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Dark blue fruit appearing in fall attracts birds
- Tolerates dry soil
- Gold fall foliage



Black Dragon Cryptomeria

Cryptomeria japonica 'Black Dragon'

Tree – Evergreen Conifer



- **Soil:** Well-drained; tolerates sandy or clay soil
- **Bloom:** Small terminal cones
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Conical shape, prized for foliage
- Named for its dark green, needle-like leaves



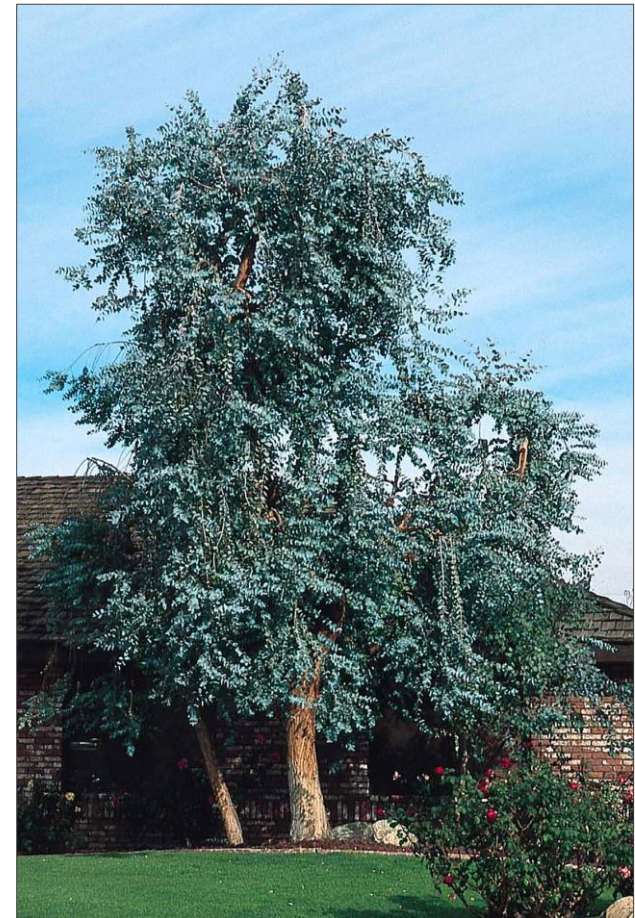
Silver Dollar Tree

Eucalyptus cinerea

Perennial – Tree - Evergreen



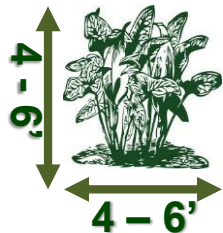
- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom Color:** Grown for foliage
- **Foliage Color:** Blue Green
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Fast growing
- Rounded blue green juvenile foliage is very aromatic when crushed
- Withstands heat, dry conditions and wind when established
- Leaves and bark are poisonous if large quantities are eaten.

Ficus carica 'Majoam' Little Miss Figgy™

Tree - Fruit



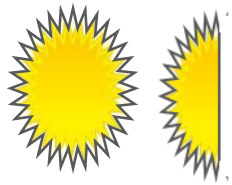
- **Soil:** Well-drained, moist
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Pollination by agaonid wasps
- May be planted in container or in ground.
- Low maintenance
- Very good disease resistance
- Somewhat deer tolerant
- Harvest in mid-September



Corkscrew Willow

Salix matsudana 'Tortuosa'

Tree - Deciduous



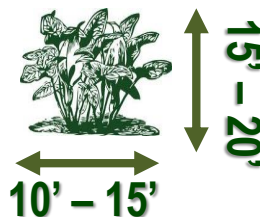
- **Soil:** Medium to Wet
- **Bloom Color:** Yellow, small non-showy
- **Bloom Time:** April – May
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Typically grown as a specimen for display of its twisted and contorted branches
- Good for rain gardens, wet areas
- Winter interest – twisted branches



Chastetree

Vitex agnus-castus 'Shoal Creek'

Tree - Deciduous



- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom Color:** Lavender-blue
- **Bloom time:** Summer
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Can grow as a large shrub or small tree
- Fragrant leaves and blooms
- Can be severely pruned in spring



Grasses

Northern Sea Oats

Chasmanthium latifolium

Perennial - Ornamental Grass



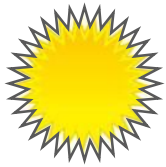
- **Soil:** Prefers rich, moist soil tolerates poor rich soil and heat
- **Bloom Color:** Green, showy seed heads turn rusty, tan, brown or bronze lasting all winter
- **Bloom Time:** June – September
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Shear spent flowers to re-bloom
 - Seeds and leaves great for fresh or dry arrangements. Self-seeds, does well in rock gardens or accent plants
 - Good source of food for birds and wildlife



Maiden Hair

Miscanthus sinensis 'Gracillimus'

Perennial - Ornamental Grass



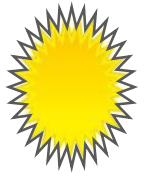
- **Soil:** Prefers well-drained soil
- **Bloom Color:** Copper maturing to silver
- **Bloom Time:** Fall
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Slower grower than other Miscanthus
 - Graceful, narrow leaf form of this popular ornamental grass



Miscanthus Strictus, also called Porcupine Grass

Miscanthus sinensis 'Strictus'

Perennial - Ornamental Grass



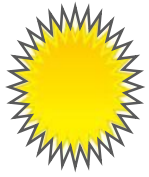
- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom Color:** Reddish-brown tassels in summer, then silvery plumes in fall
- **Leaves:** Medium green, variegated with yellow horizontal bands
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Winter interest

Muhlenbergia capillaris

Perennial - Ornamental Grass



Summer Foliage

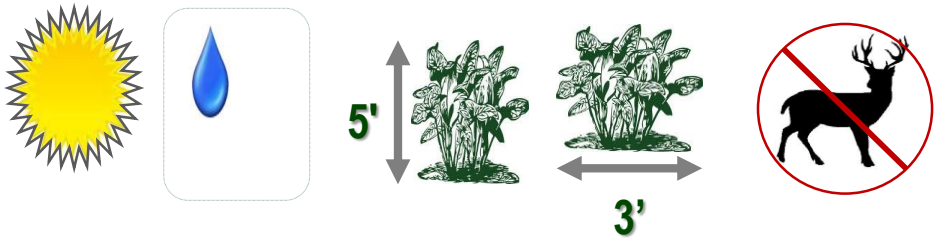
- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom:** Airy Plumes of Pink
- **Bloom Time:** Late Fall
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Airy inflorescence often colored pink, purplish red, purplish gray; dries to a light buff



Lindheimer's Muhly

Muhlenbergia lindheimeri

Perennial - Ornamental Grass



- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom:** Light purplish gray in fall; long lasting
- **Bloom Time:** Late fall
- **Foliage:** Bluish
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- The grass has lovely cloud-like masses of silvery seed heads floating above the foliage

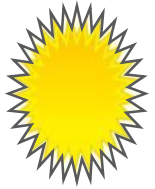


Blue Switchgrass

Panicum virgatum 'Heavy Metal'



Perennial - Ornamental Grass



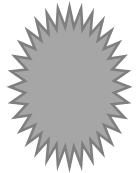
- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom Color:** Striking Metallic Blue
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Good cut flower
 - Upright erect, seldom falls over



Switch Grass

Panicum virgatum 'Ruby Ribbons'

Perennial - Ornamental Grass



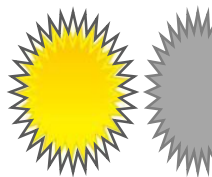
- **Soil:** Prefers moist, sandy or clay
- **Bloom Color:** Smoky purple
- **Bloom Time:** Summer
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Slowly spreads, forms clumps
 - Good for rain gardens
 - Cut back to the ground in late winter to early spring
 - Good for erosion control
 - Seeds are food for the birds.



Dwarf Fountain Grass

Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hameln'

Ornamental Grass

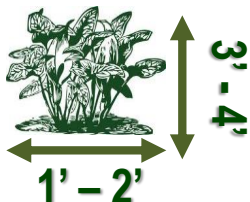


- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Bloom Color:** White
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Arching, deep green foliage in an upright clump
 - Leaves are deep green in summer, orange-bronze in fall, beige in late fall
 - Flower spikes - showy, silvery to pinkish-white, wheat-like, in late summer
 - Brownish spikes persist until late fall or early winter before shattering
 - Good in fresh or dry arrangements

Little Bluestem

Schizachyrium scoparium 'Smoke Signal'

Ornamental Grass



- **Soil:** Average to nutrient-poor soil / well drained to dry soil
- **Bloom Color:** Tan
- **Bloom Time:** Early fall
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
- Grown for attractive foliage, blue green in summer, red purple in fall
- Easy to grow in loam, sand and clay
- Suitable for beds, borders, rain gardens



Vines

Carolina Jessamine

Gelsemium sempervirens

Vine - Evergreen



- **Soil:** Moist soil is ideal until established
- **Bloom Color:** Yellow, trumpet-shaped
- **Bloom Time:** February to April
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Highly scented flowers
 - Blooms appear in February providing nectar for pollinators such as native bees and Spicebush swallowtail butterflies
 - May be trellised or used as ground cover
 - Vine can climb to 20 ft.
 - **All parts of this plant are poisonous**



Ferns

Autumn Fern

Dryopteris erythrosora 'Brilliance'

Perennial - Fern



- **Soil:** Well-drained, moist
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Evergreen hardy fern with copper color new growth
 - More drought tolerant than most ferns

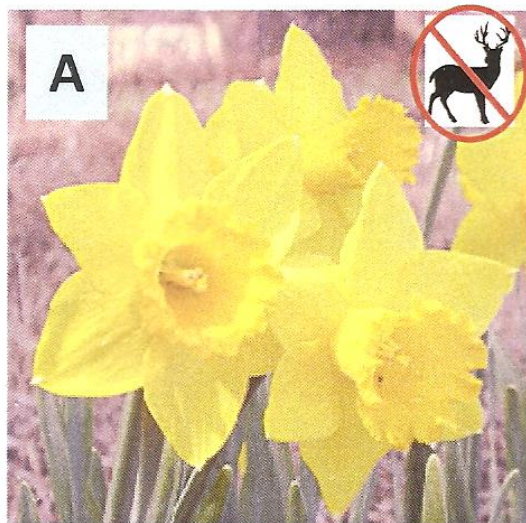

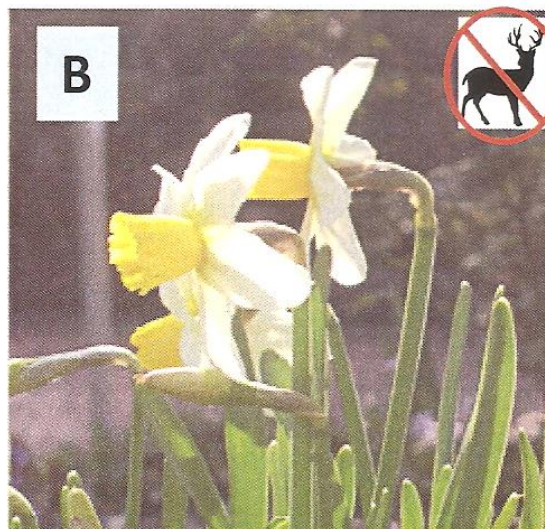
2016 Fall Fundraising Bulb Selections

These top quality bulbs come from a local nursery and are true-to-name bloomers! All orders are hand picked, hand packed, healthy, and include planting instructions.

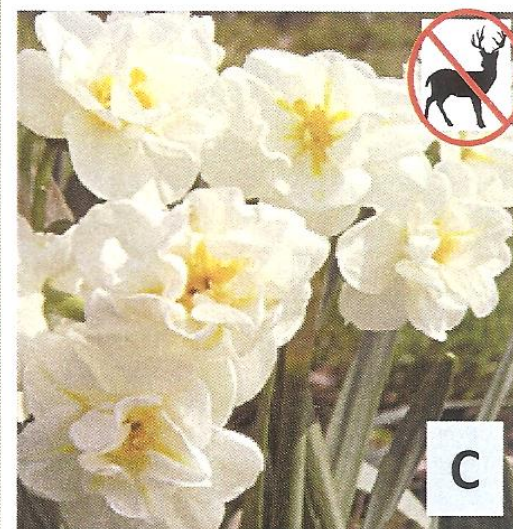

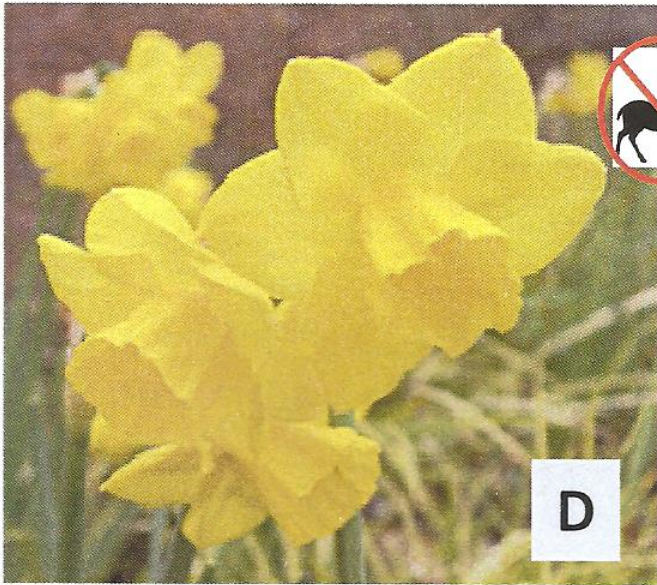
'St Keverne' Daffodil
large cup daffodil, one flower
per stem; 16" tall



'Jack Snipe' Daffodil
2 to 3 pendulous flowers
per stem; 6" tall

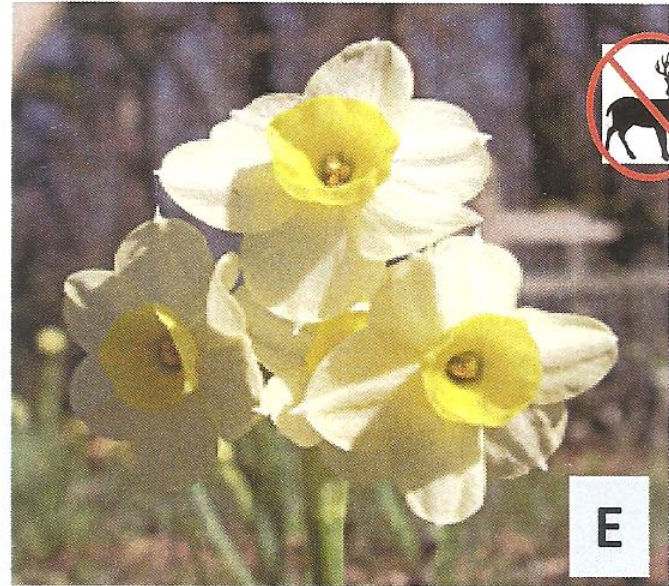


'Cheerfulness' Daffodil
one or more double flowers
per stem; 16" tall



'Quail' Daffodil

multiple small flowers on single stem;
known for their fragrance; 16" tall



'Minnow' Daffodil

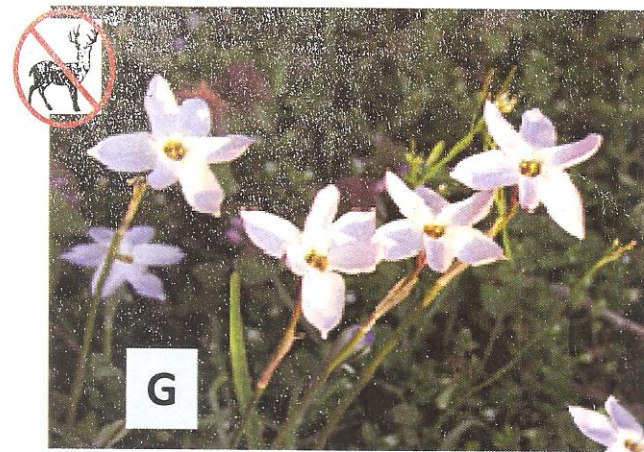
terrific in rock gardens or grass; clusters
of extremely fragrant flowers 8" tall

A through E: Daffodils Sun to part shade, bloom in March,
heights vary. Suggested planting rate: 3 bulbs per square foot (3/SqFt)



Spanish Bluebells

bell shaped flowers on thick stems with lush foliage; tolerates moist conditions and shade; blooms April/May; 12"-16" tall (5/SqFt)



Crocus Mix

great natural areas or rock garden; produces masses of flowers; sun to part shade; blooms in early spring; 4" tall (10/SqFt)



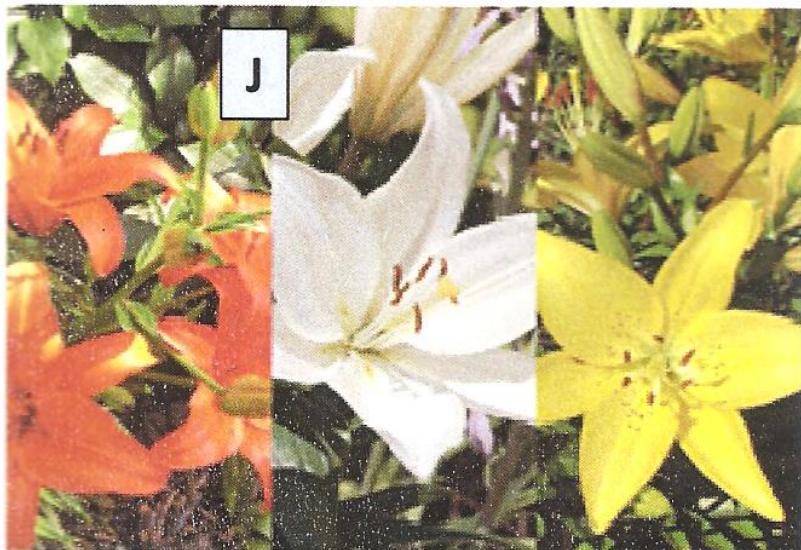
Summer Snowflake 'Gravetye Giant'

bell shaped flowers on arching stems; tolerates moist soil; sun; blooms in April; 20"-24" tall (5/SqFt)



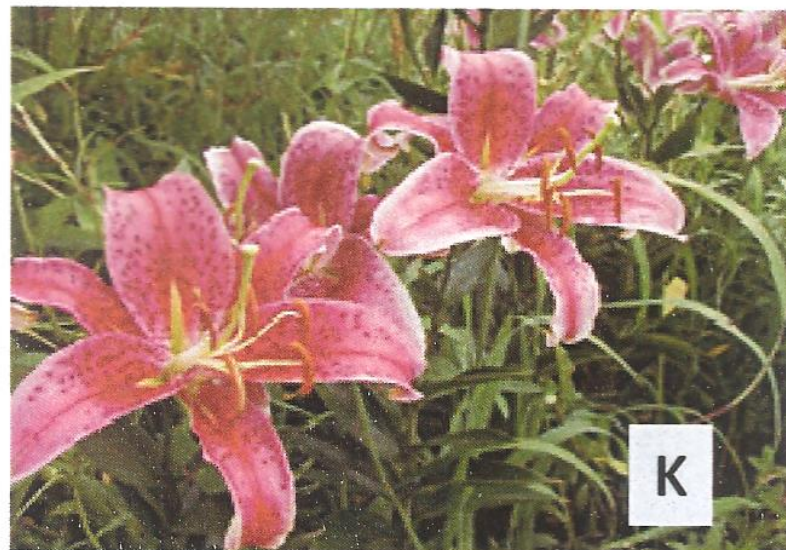
Tulip 'Cynthia'

perfect for borders or containers; this tulip thrives in warm climate; unusual shapes and sizes sun to part shade; blooms in April; 14"-18" tall (5/SqFt)



Lily Asiatic Mix

many flowers on a single stem; great for cutting or border; multiply readily and fill in gap between spring and summer flowering bulbs; full sun; blooms in May-June; 26"-30" tall (3/SqFt)



Oriental Lily 'Stargazer'

6-10 sweet scented blooms; great for cutting; multiply readily and fill in gap between spring and summer flowers; full sun; blooms in June-July; 32"-36" tall (3/SqFt)
